



JOINT PRESS RELEASE

Following a positive discussion between senior representatives of Nottingham City Council and the Indian Community Centre Association (ICCA) yesterday, it was agreed to issue a joint statement to reassure service users of the Indian Day Care Centre that there are no proposals to close the Centre, its day services or the special care provided by the City Council.

The City Council is reviewing all its day care services across the City to ensure specialist care continues to be provided to eligible users. There is no proposal to close or relocate this specialist service from the ICCA. The Council and ICCA will work together to explore how the service can be retained and increased at the ICCA in the face of anticipated reduced demand as a result of Personal Budgets and competitive pressure from the private sector.
